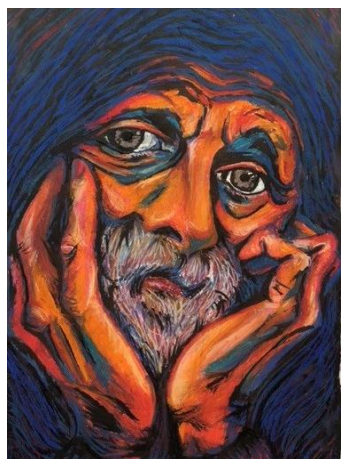
## VISUAL ART & CERAMICS

- Art students enjoy working in our beautifully refurbished Visual Art Studio
- Art students continue to create beautiful and dynamic examples of their chosen medium
- Year 12 Visual Diaries and Artists Books are seen as exemplars by ACT College Teachers at Moderation
- Art Students are invited to participate in annual workshops in a variety of disciplines at the ANU School of Art College Program
- Students can study a Tertiary or Accredited or M accreditation and can complete a minor, major, major/minor or double major in Visual Arts, including up to four units of Ceramics
- Every term we hold an Art exhibition to showcase student work.



## DANCE

- Students can learn a variety of styles of dance developing technical skill, performing repertoire, creating original choreography and collaborating with other artists
- We have guest artists and companies regularly facilitate workshops with the dancers
- Sydney Dance Company held a workshop for our dance students in the CCPAC dance studio
- Dance students can perform regularly at College Open Night/s and *Dance Showcase*, *Limelight* and *Dancefest*
- Students perform in *Quantum Leap Ensemble* and audition for tertiary dance institutions around Australia
- **Students can study a Tertiary or Accredited or M accreditation** and can complete a minor, major major/minor, or double major in Dance
- Come along to our *Dance Showcase* – held twice a year at the end of each semester in the theatre



## MEDIA

- CC students achieve success at events such as the Canberra Short Film Festival – we placed 1st Place Music Video and we had 7 finalists across five genres in previous festivals
- Students with a screen focus create films in diverse genres using differing techniques, including mockumentaries, short films, computer generated animation, stop motion animation, trailers, green screening, documentaries and music videos
- Students who focus on digital media learn to create websites and make interactive games using Adobe After Effects
- **Students can study a Tertiary or Accredited or M accreditation** and can complete a minor, major/ double major in Media





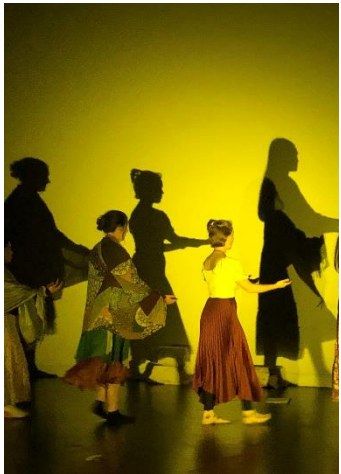
## DRAMA

- There are Drama classes available for a variety of different student pathways: the aspiring serious performer as well as the interested amateur
- Drama students perform at local community festivals such as Come Alive and ACTUp!
- Sydney Drama tours in the past have included tours of the Opera Centre, where the props, costumes and sets for the Opera are made, performance workshops at Belvoir St Theatre and N.I.D.A. A show at STC and the Sydney Opera House and visit the Art Gallery of NSW and Chinatown
- **Students can study a Tertiary or Accredited or M accreditation** and can complete a minor, major, major/minor or double major in Drama.
- Drama and Theatre students perform major productions in our CCPAC theatre each semester.



## MUSIC & MUSIC INDUSTRY

- Canberra College Music students have participated in the ANU school of Music type 1 course (admittance through audition)
- The College Jazz Band students perform every year at the *Merimbula Festival*, just one of the many performance opportunities available
- Music Industry vocational students can complete Industry related work experience placements
- Music Industry students are encouraged to get involved as assistants at local music festivals and events
- **Students can study a Tertiary or Accredited or M accreditation** and can complete a minor, major, major/minor or double major in Music
- Music Industry as a Vocational study option gives opportunities for training in *Industry Standard Recording and Live Production*.

## TRADITIONAL & DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHY

- Photography students study black & white, alternative and digital
- Canberra College photography students have regularly 'scooped the pool' in various state and national photography exhibitions and competitions, including Ilford *'Best Photography Department'* of the year
- Students participate in work experience with local and inter-state professional photographers
- Students have the opportunity to participate in workshops at the A.N.U. and C.I.T.
- Student work is exhibited within the college and students are encouraged to exhibit at external venues
- Students can complete a minor, major or major/minor. All classes can be completed at tertiary or accredited or M level.
